### **Introduction and Background**

Children as a Zone of Peace (CZOP) National Campaign, established in 2001, is a coalition of civil society organizations and INGOs dedicated to the protection and promotion of child rights. A core strategy of CZOP is advocating for the inclusion of child rights and protection issues in political agendas, specifically through election manifestos.

Following the elections for the House of Representatives in 2082, it is essential to assess how political commitments are being translated into state action. This consultancy will analyze the alignment between the published Manifestos, the National Commitment Paper, the Annual Policy & Program, and the Fiscal Budget for the year 2083/84, with a specific lens on 'Priorities for Children'.

### **Overall Objective**

- To review and analyze the manifestos of major political parties from a child rights perspective.
- To evaluate the integration of child-centric commitments within the National Commitment Paper and the Annual Policy & Program (2083/84).
- To conduct a gap analysis of the Fiscal Budget (2083/84) to determine the level of financial resource allocation for children.
- To produce a comprehensive report and a high-impact summary brief for advocacy and record-keeping.

### **Scope of Work**

- Review of major political party manifestos (2082) focusing on child protection, education, and development.
- Analysis of the government's National Commitment Paper and how it consolidates election promises.
- Tracking 'Priorities for Children' within the 2083/84 Annual Policy & Program (e.g., Street Child-Free initiative, Digital Literacy).
- Detailed review of the 2083/84 Fiscal Budget to identify Child-Responsive Budgeting (CRB) indicators and specific line items.
- Synthesis of findings into a final report and a 4-page Summary Brief.

### **Deliverables of the Assignment**

Develop a comprehensive report by analyzing the alignment between the published Manifestos, the National Commitment Paper, the Annual Policy & Program, and the Fiscal Budget for the year 2083/84, with a specific lens on 'Priorities for Children'.
